We are pleased to announce the opportunity for 5 of you to be awarded a scholarship to study Italian language and culture in Perugia, thanks to Università per Stranieri di Perugia.

5 scholarships for a 1-month course - **From August to December 2026**

Application deadline: Monday, 04.05.2026 at midnight

Here you will find all the information you need:

A. Who can apply:

- 1- Students of all ages and nationalities enrolled in CIC courses in/from January 2024
- 2- Students of all ages and nationalities currently living in Italy or Europe with a valid codice fiscale, permesso di soggiorno, and a valid passport.

Please note: You cannot apply if you received **any** scholarship sponsored by the Università per Stranieri di Perugia in the previous 3 years.

B. Courses, scholarship and residence information:

- 1- Courses are organized by the Università per Stranieri and **held in Perugia**. The scholarship covers only face-to-face courses. You will study 18 hours a week with lessons every day (Mon-Fri),
- 2- Courses last between 25 to 29 days, except in December (20 days), depending on the calendar. Please note that **not** all the levels are available every month. - 3- We will select and contact successful applicants to invite them for a **Zoom meeting** to answer all questions and doubts. Selected students will then receive an acceptance email from the university and the procedures to enroll in their system.
- 4- Before the course begins, students will take an online placement test directly with the university, as well as an oral test upon their arrival in Perugia.
- 5- The scholarship is **500 euros** for a 1-month course. Students will receive the amount in their bank account towards the end of their stay. (The University of Perugia will give you more details about this process.)
- 6- Students can choose to live in the university's dormitories or arrange independently for other accommodation (B&B, hotels, hostels, private apartments, shared flats, etc).

***Notice:** Remember that the moment you are selected, we will communicate your details to the University of Perugia, which will manage all formal aspects of enrollment. Changing the selected month after registration might result in losing the scholarship.

B.1. Dormitory rules (if you choose the dorm):

1- Age limit: In order to access the dorm, students must be under **28 years old**.

2- Shared rooms cost 220 euros (not refundable) per person per month, to be paid upfront to the University upon acceptance of the scholarship to secure limited space. The payment covers the duration of the course. Students can only access the room on the first day of the course and must leave it on the last. (If you arrive the night before, you have to arrange for a hotel.)

C. How you can apply:

The CIC Staff will select 5 successful students from all applications received.

To apply for the Italian language scholarship in Perugia, you are required to submit **one** PDF document containing:

1 - MOTIVATION LETTER

- Length: **200–350 words**
- Language: Clear and simple **English** or **Italian**

Your letter should include:

- A short introduction about yourself
- Which month you would like to go to Perugia (from August to December 2026)
- Why you want to learn / are learning Italian
- Why you are applying for this scholarship and how it would support you
- Your future goals and how Italian will help you
- Why you are a good candidate

2 - SHORT ESSAY IN ITALIAN

- Length: **80-150 words**
- **Topic: Which is your favourite Italian song and why?**

Your essay should include:

- The title of the song and the name of the singer
- What the song is about and the reason(s) why you like it
- Where you heard it for the first time

We expect simple texts that show your ability to **use the Italian language that you know**, even if you are a beginner student of Italian.

Here an example (92 words, A2 level)

La mia canzone italiana preferita è "Un'estate al mare" di Giuni Russo. Non è una canzone nuova, è del 1981. Mi piace molto la voce della cantante e la musica allegra. La canzone parla delle vacanze e del mare. Io amo molto nuotare al mare e prendere il sole in spiaggia. Questa canzone mi fa pensare all'estate, per questo mi piace molto. Ho sentito la canzone per la prima volta a una festa, tutti gli invitati italiani cantavano e ballavano. Ho cercato su YouTube e ora è la mia suoneria del cellulare.
